RESOLUTION NO. 2023-12

WHEREAS, the Township of Franklin has an Ordinance entitled "AN ORDINANCE PROVIDING FOR THE COLLECTION BY THE TOWNSHIP OF FRANKLIN OF GARBAGE, RUBBISH AND ASHES; DEFINING MEANING OF TERMS AS USED IN THIS ORDINANCE; IMPOSING CERTAIN DUTIES UPON HOUSEHOLDERS AND OTHERS; PROVIDING FOR ENFORCEMENT THEREOF; AND REPEALING FRANKLIN TOWNSHIP ORDINANCE NO. 86-1 AND ANY AND ALL AMENDMENTS THERETO," being Ordinance No. 02-02 of the Township of Franklin, as amended from time to time ("Ordinance"); and

WHEREAS, Section 7 of the Ordinance provides that "the Supervisors of Franklin Township from time to time, may establish by Resolution the rate, including discounts and penalties, to be charged for the collection of refuse"; and

WHEREAS, by Resolution No. 2022-21, adopted on December 20, 2022, the Supervisors of Franklin Township established the rates, including discounts and penalties, to be charged for refuse collection services; and

WHEREAS, Section 4(B)(2) of the Ordinance provides, "No person shall use for the reception of garbage any receptacle having a capacity of more than thirty gallons and a total weight of such receptacle and its contents shall not exceed 50 lbs."; and

WHEREAS, Section 5(B)(1) of the Ordinance provides, "It is the intent of the ordinance that the reasonable accumulation of refuse of each family, or housekeeping unit, for the collection period will be collected for the standard charge. The Township Supervisors may refuse to collect unreasonable amounts or may make an additional charge for such amounts. Each family or housekeeping unit should have no more than four 30 gallon containers of refuse per week. Any amount in excess of four 30 gallon containers of refuse per week shall be deemed unreasonable"; and

WHEREAS, the Supervisors of Franklin Township, by this Resolution desire to set an additional charge for each family or housekeeping unit which places out for collection in excess of four 30 gallon containers of refuse for per week; and

NOW, THEREFORE, be it hereby resolved as follows:

- 1. Each family or housekeeping unit which places out for collection more than four containers (not to exceed 30 gallons per container) shall be billed \$5.00 per container in excess of four.
- Resolution No. 2022-21 shall remain in full force and effect as amended by this Resolution.
